Your orders will bring you to South Texas, also known as the home of the famous 832,000 acre King Ranch. Kingsville has a population of approximately 25,000 people, not including military personnel or university students. Kingsville has many of the attributes of a larger city, but it is also a place which has retained its small town traditions and customs. The people here are friendly and appreciate their military neighbors. An excellent rapport has always existed with the towns people and they have a high regard for military service members and their families. You and your family can become involved in the community and find a hometown atmosphere to the extent that you desire. You can be assured of a warm welcome.

Financial Institutions: Several (4+) full service
banks. On NAS Kingsville, you will find a Wells
Fargo Bank and an Army Navy Federal Credit Union.
Navy Federal Credit Union (NFCU) is located in
Portland, TX (approximately 1 hr. north of
Kingsville. If you currently have a NFCU account, it
is highly recommended that you keep your account
open. You can cash NFCU checks at the Navy
Exchange and at H.E.B. (a local grocery chain).
NFCU also offers a website and 1-800 number for
additional services.

The famous King Ranch which sprawls across
825,000 acres of South Texas with land that varies
from fertile black farmland to low lying coastal
marshes to pastures with numerous mesquite trees
that mark the beginning of the great Texas brush
country. Covering more than 1,300 squares miles, it
is larger than the entire state of Rhode Island, and it
is the home of 60,000 Santa Gertrudis cattle and 300
registered Quarter Horses. Kingsville was founded in
1904 and occupies land that was once part of the
Rincon de Santa Gertrudis Spanish land grant
purchased by Captain Richard King in 1853. King, a
steamboat operator on the Rio Grande, became
interested in the area while riding horseback from
Brownsville to Corpus Christi. Attracted by the lush,
grassy coastal plains, King built his ranch on the
Santa Gertrudis Creek. Mrs. King later deeded more
than 40,000 acres for townsite and Kingsville was
founded. King Ranch also gave land for the
development of the railroad in South Texas.

LOCATION: Naval Air Station Kingsville is located 1 mile east of Highway 77 in Kingsville, Texas (take the Senator Carlos Truan exit, turn left underneath the underpass and continue to the gate). NAS Kingsville is approximately 44 miles from Corpus Christi, Texas.

If you are arriving in the local area by commercial transportation, contact the NASK Security Department at (361) 516-6217 or DSN 876-6217 for transportation assistance to the station. Leave your name, rank and a number where you can be reached so that the Command Duty Officer (CDO) can return your call for assistance. If the CDO reports military transportation is not available from Corpus Christi International Airport, a taxi to Kingsville will cost approximately fifty (\$50) dollars and is reimbursable on your PCS travel claim.

CHECKING IN: ALL PERSONNEL arriving for duty at NAS Kingsville report to NAS Security in building 4728. After logging in, all personnel are directed to their respective Command Administration Departments for further processing.

Personnel reporting for duty with VT-21,VT-22, or COMTRAWING TWO should report to the NAS Security Dept. in Bldg. 4728, then to their Administration Departments for processing, then to the respective squadron duty officer or the TRAWING TWO duty officer for further processing.

LODGING: NAS Kingsville has a BOQ, a BEQ and a Combined Bachelor's Quarters (CBQ) which is available to all military personnel PCSing with family. The CBQ includes units with one bedroom/kitchen and bath and 2 bedroom/2 bath, living room/kitchen suites. Rates vary from \$14-25 per night and are subject to change. Contact the CBQ at 361/516-6321 or DSN 876-6321 for more information. The Kingsville community has several local hotels within a close proximity to NAS Kingsville. If you are househunting or on PCS orders, consider staying at the Combined Bachelors Quarters. Hotels in the area are approx. \$30 p/night more than the CBQ.

SCHOOLS: Information you should know and may want to ask about: (1) where your child goes to school depends upon the area of the city in which you live; (2) some schools in the Kingsville area have a required dress code; and (3) Texas students in the 10th grade are required to take an exit Texas Assessment of Academic Skills (TAAS) exam. Additional information is available by contacting the school district administration office (see Education section for phone numbers). School in South Texas begins in mid-August and some schools are year-round. Once a year, prior to the beginning of school, Texas offers 3-days tax free school shopping (clothes and shoes, not school supplies).

TRICARE: You can access the local health care facilities by calling (361) 516-6160/6260 or DSN 876-6160/6260. The TRICARE Service Center is located inside the Branch Medical Clinic (Bldg. 3775). Tricare's phone number is 1-800-406-2832. The Health Benefits Advisor is also located inside the Branch Medical Clinic at (361) 516-6493/6313. **NOTE:** To avoid a lapse in coverage or any problems, it is to your advantage to NOT DISENROLL from your current region contractor until you reach your new assignment location here in South Texas. Upon arrival, stop by the TRICARE Service Center and complete an enrollment application.

Regulations

Active duty drivers & Texas residents on active duty must possess a current/valid state drivers license. When a nonresident owner or operator establishes residency in Texas or enters into gainful employment, his or her vehicle(s) may be operated for 30 days after which time the vehicle must be registered in Texas.

Seat belts are mandatory for all occupants of any motor vehicle operated in the state of Texas. NOTE: Passengers may be cited and fined by law enforcement officer.

All motor vehicles registered in Texas, including motorcycles, motor scooters and mopeds, must be inspected each year by an official motor vehicle inspection station.

Motorcycles or motor driven cycles-both military members and dependents must have an endorsement for motor cycle on their license and a special written and riding skills class/test is required.

Personnel reporting aboard with vehicles should register with the Pass and Tag Office at the main gate upon arrival and obtain a station decal. The following items are required for issuance of a station decal: current state motor vehicle inspection sticker, proof of insurance, current vehicle registration and driver's license.

FISHING and HUNTING LICENSE: Licenses are sold at most sporting goods and tackle stores, county courthouses, Parks & Wildlife Dept. offices, and by some, not all, local game wardens. All annual licenses are valid from Sept.1 through the following Aug.31, no matter when purchased.

LICENSES-COMBINATION: Available for Texas residents only, a combination hunting and fishing license costs \$25.00.

FISHING LICENSES: A fishing license is required for all nonresident fishermen. For residents, only those between 17 and 65 years of age are required to have a fishing license. Saltwater stamps and freshwater trout stamps are not required for those who are exempt from fishing licenses.
RESIDENT, ANNUAL: \$8.00,
RESIDENT, TEMPORARY (14-days): \$5.00,
NONRESIDENT, ANNUAL: \$15.00 (No age exemptions, except for residents of Oklahoma, Louisiana, and Kansas.)
NONRESIDENT, TEMPORARY 5-Days: \$8.00,
SALTWATER STAMP: \$5.00, **RAINBOW TROUT STAMP:** \$5.00.

HUNTING LICENSES: RESIDENT: \$10.00. Required of all Texas citizens. Texans under 17 or over 65 years of age do not need a regular hunting license, but must have a \$6.00 Resident Exempt Hunting License. **NONRESIDENT GENERAL HUNTING:** \$200.00, Valid for all game species. **NONRESIDENT SMALL GAME:** \$75.00. Valid for nongame animals and all game birds except turkey; not valid for game species except squirrels. **NONRESIDENT 5-Day:** \$25.00 Not valid for deer or turkey.

HUNTING AND FISHING IN MEXICO: Mexican authorities must be contacted for current regulations, hunting and fishing licenses, and procedures for taking in firearms and ammunition. Any game legally taken in Mexico may be brought into Texas, but must be accompanied by a statement, issued by U.S. Customs at the border, that the game originated in Mexico. There are no restrictions on bringing fish caught in Mexico into Texas, but they must be declared at the Texas port of entry.

The particular elementary or middle school that your child will attend depends on your home location within Kingsville. A pre-kindergarten child must be four years of age on or before 1 September of the year of enrollment. For kindergarten children, the age is five as of 1 September of the year of enrollment. First graders who are underage may be enrolled if they have been attending first grade in the public school system of another state prior to moving to Kingsville. Information on which school to attend may be obtained by calling the Administration office, 592-3387, Ext. 114. Transportation to a school location is provided to all elementary students, and to middle and high school students who live two or more miles from the assigned location. Kingsville owns and operates approximately 20 buses that run on 10 regular routes and 3 special routes. In addition to the regular academic and physical education programs, there are handicapped, early-childhood, deafness, and specific-need programs within the school system. Further information is available from the school at registration or by calling transportation, 361-592-3387, Ext. 115. To maintain the high standards for students health, all new students' parents need to bring immunization records when registering their children. State law requires DPT / TB, polio, measles, rubella, and mumps inoculations at various ages. The Branch Medical Clinic will provide the required immunizations for properly DEERS enrolled military sponsored children. On a related note, the Kingsville School District

may administer medication to a child during school hours provided that the district is requested to do so in writing, and that the medication is still in its original container (additional restrictions may be imposed by a school's nurse).

Much more information concerning the Kingsville Independent School District is available from the Administration and Tax Office located at 207 North 3rd Street.

NO EMERGENCY SERVICES: The Branch Medical Clinic does not have an emergency room and should not be used for emergencies at any time. Emergency care is defined as "Medical conditions with severe, life threatening, or potentially disabling conditions that require immediate intervention to prevent suffering or loss of limb and/or dental treatment of acute conditions." Acute care is a condition that occurs suddenly or an old (chronic) condition that suddenly gets worse. An acute condition is not necessarily an emergency. Active duty personnel reporting to a civilian facility will be liable for billing if the condition does not meet the

definition of emergency care. Word of advice: OMA has refused to pay bills that are non-emergency. Non-active duty cannot be seen for emergency care at this clinic at any time.

Effective 1 August, 1998, the military ambulance will not respond to base calls. Calls will be responded to by the Kingsville city ambulances. If you live in the Kingsville community, you will dial 911 for ambulance service. If you are calling from the base, you will need to dial 9-911. Family Housing, called Texas Terrace, is located off base in the city of Kingsville. On base housing consists of Quarters A, which is the Commodore's residence, Quarters B, which is the CO's residence, Bachelor Enlisted Quarters, Bachelor Officer

Quarters, and some temporary and limited family quarters in the BOQ area.

PROCEDURE FOR ADVANCE HOUSING APPLICATION: To be placed on the waiting list prior to your arrival at NAS Kingsville, you must fill out an APPLICATION FOR ASSIGNMENT TO HOUSING (DD FORM 1746, S/N 0102-LF-002-9100). Forward this form to the address above with a copy of your official, signed orders (with detachment endorsement), and 1 copy of your page 2 (with a "verified by" signature) or Record of Emergency Data (Marines/Army).

PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING ON-BASE HOUSING UPON ARRIVAL: To be placed on the waiting list upon your arrival, you must comply with your written orders and report to the Housing Welcome Center and provide the papers enumerated in the preceding paragraph.

TEXAS TERRACE: The Navy family Housing complex consists of 243 units, with 2, 3, and 4 bedrooms apartments for officers and enlisted personnel. All apartments are equipped with kitchen range, refrigerators, garbage disposal, central heat and air conditioning, as well as washer and dryer connections.

All enlisted/officer personnel with accompanying family members are eligible for housing. Assignment to a unit is based on family size and availability of housing units. Pets are allowed in Navy Housing units. The Kingsville Police Department and NAS Security Department share jurisdiction in Navy Housing. Waterbeds are not allowed in Navy Housing. A Mini-mart, picnic areas, tennis court, and basketball court are situated within the housing area for your convenience and pleasure, as well as several playground areas for children. A community center is located in Navy Housing that can be reserved for events such as meetings, parties, and the like.

Because of the demand for Navy quarters, arriving personnel generally must be placed on a waiting list for a varying amount of time. It is the policy of the Station to fully utilize the Government provided quarters. While you are awaiting assignment to family housing, our Housing Welcome Center will assist you in locating suitable, affordable, temporary housing in the community, or, possibly, locating housing for your full tour at Kingsville. Your orders will instruct you to come by and check in at the Housing Welcome Center, located at 1201 East Caesar Street in Kingsville. There are times when

immediate assignment into housing is possible, so be sure to check through the office before you make any arrangements for off-base housing.

COMMUNITY HOUSING: Comes in all shapes, sizes, and price range. There are several nice apartment complexes, offering 1-2-3 bedroom units. These are all equipped with kitchen range, refrigerator, dishwasher, garbage disposal, carpet, and drapes, central heat and air conditioning. All have swimming pools in their areas. There are two complexes with clothes washer and dryer hook-ups inside the units. The remainder have common laundry facilities located within the complex. Pets are allowed in the two complexes upon paying a pet deposit fee, but only upon rare occasions are pets allowed into other community housing. Most complexes have a pet size/weight limit.

Kingsville also has Hawks Landing, the Navy's 1st Public Private Venture (PPV) housing consisting of 100 units and is located about 1 mile from base and offers 2 and 3 bedroom units each with two bathrooms. Kingsville opened its second Public Private Venture housing, "Hunters Cove", in October 2001. Hunters Cove is also located about 1-2 miles from base and offers 3 and 4 bedroom units. Each unit has a carport, exterior storage, central AC/H and free basic cable. Both PPVs are located in close proximity to shopping and schools.

Prices between apartment complexes vary. The complexes recommended by the Housing Welcome Center range from \$300 - \$400 per month for a one bedroom unit; \$335 - \$565 per month for a two-bedroom unit; and \$410 - \$650 per month for a three bedroom unit. In apartment complexes, the usual utilities you pay are the electric service and your telephone; some renters also pay for water service. An agreement between the Navy and Central Power and Light Company allows for a waiver of the electric deposit. Forms are available at the "HOUSING WELCOME CENTER". Utility deposits and cost per month can be very expensive. AC units can be used all year round in Kingsville (with 9-10.5 months a good avg.).

The Housing Welcome Center maintains an up-to-date list of rental houses in the area. The realty companies here usually list their rentals with the Housing Welcome Center. Two bedroom, one-bath houses can be found readily in Kingsville. Nicer houses in this category, in an acceptable neighborhood, are the hardest to find. Most are older houses with window air conditioners and natural gas jets for heating. This is not as efficient as central heating and air conditioning units that the higher priced and newer houses have. There are newer three bedroom, two-bath houses for rent or sale in

acceptable neighborhoods. Generally, Kingsville has a rental or sale house that will fit your particular need. Some military and civilian officials have expressed a concern that housing may become, or is becoming, difficult to find. This may be true especially for the junior officer flight students who choose not to live in the BOQ. To remedy this somewhat, junior officer flight students are no longer required to live within geographically specific areas surrounding the base.

Billeting

Located in Building 3729, The Family Transient Housing provides temporary quarters for personnel and their families who are arriving or preparing to depart on permanent change of station (PCS) orders.

Stays are limited to 30 days for PCS incoming personnel and 10 for PCS outgoing personnel.

10 suites are available for occupancy. All rooms can accommodate a family of four and include a full bath, beds, linens, closet space, chairs, night stands and lamps. There is one central lounge provided. A large

Comments: The School Age Care Program is designed to assist DOD military and civilian personnel in balancing the demands of family and military work life and is a Quality of Life benefit. The program provides a safe, supervised, healthy and age-appropriate environments for children in grades K-6, ages 5-12 and complements the school day. MWR is the primary sponsor of the program but is operated as part of the Child Development Program. The Youth Center offers a After School Program with hours of operation from M-F, 2:00pm-5:15pm. DoD requires the use of uniform fees which are based on total family income and apply to all children who attend on a regular basis. Depending on your rank, fees can start as low as \$15 & up per week. The After School Program offers transportation from schools and organized/supervised recreational activities. Attendance is closely monitored at all times. Parents are required to sign their children in/out of the program. A ration of one staff member to 15 children is required. The Youth Center also offers Summer-Holiday Day Camps for children between the ages of 5-12(older teens may be included as teen leaders). Registration can be for the entire summer or weekly. Volunteers are often used to assist the staff with the administration of the program/camps. Volunteers do not serve as replacements for paid personnel. All volunteers are given a program orientation.

Before You Move

Please visit the Relocation Assistance Office for information about your next duty station. Request a Welcome Aboard Package be sent to your home address.

Request that a SITES Booklet be prepared for you. These booklets are updated 4 times a year and covers information on the installation, local community, education, employment, medical and dental, housing relocation services, support services, child and teen services, and survival tips for first termers.

After You Arrive

Upon your arrival at NAS Kingsville, the Relocation Assistance office can provide settling-in services. Whatever your question, if we do not know the answer, we probably can put you in touch with someone who can. Let us tell you about the different programs and services available to you at the Family Service Center.

Reporting Procedures

If you are arriving in the local area by commercial transportation, contact the Command Duty Officer (CDO) at (512) 516-6136 or DSN 876-6136 for transportation to the station. If the CDO reports military transportation is not available from Corpus Christi International Airport, a taxi to Kingsville will cost approximately fifty dollars and is reimbursable on your PCS travel claim.

CHECKING IN: All personnel arriving for duty at NAS Kingsville report to the NAS duty officer in building 2740. After logging in, all personnel are directed to the Personnel Support Detachment for further processing.

Personnel reporting for duty with VT-21,VT-22, or COMTRAWING TWO should report to the NAS duty officer, then to Personnel Support Detachment for processing, then to the respective squadron duty officer or the TRAWING TWO duty officer for further processing.

Travel Planning

The Relocation Assistance Program (RAP) is designed to assist military personnel and DOD personnel and their families who are relocating to a new duty station, being deployed, or who are separating or retiring from service.

The RAP educates military and DOD personnel and their family members about relocating, enhancing their skills, to make the transition from one community to another as trouble-free and smooth as possible.

PRE-DEPARTURE INFORMATION: SITES: This computer information retrieval system has been designed for use by members of all of the Services, so information about military installations that have a Family Service Center or the equivalent is readily available to relocating service personnel and their families. The SITES program is updated 4 times a year. **"WELCOME ABOARD PACKAGES":** from Navy and Marines installations world-wide are

available at the Relocation Assistance office. They may be checked out by the service member or by his/her spouse for a short period of time. The RAP will be happy to request a customized Welcome Aboard Package from another installation for you.

Receiving Permanent Change of Station (PCS) orders and arrangement of household goods begins once the service member receives orders from PSD and a designation site has been determined. An appointment date must be obtained by the service member to meet with the Personal Property clerk since each pay grade has its own weight allowance. Be sure to set up a counseling appointment once new PCS orders are in hand for a smooth coordination of all shipments arrangement.

Vehicle Ownership

Personnel reporting aboard with vehicles should register with the Pass and Tag Office at the main gate upon arrival and obtain a station decal. The following items are required for issuance of a station decal: current state motor vehicle inspection sticker, proof of insurance coverage and current vehicle registration and driver's license.

Money Matters

The Navy Marine Corp Relief Society can provide financial emergency assistance based upon need, through either loans or, when there is a particular hardship, grants.
