Mission: The primary mission is to provide logistical support for tenant activities and other commands as assigned by Chief of Naval Operations.

To carry out this mission, we are supported by a daytime population of about 5,000 active duty personnel, 2,700 civilian and contract employees, 700 military family members residing on base and 5,700 retirees in the surrounding community.

HISTORY

For more than 125 years the Navy has called the west bank of the Mississippi River in New Orleans home. In February 1849 the acres on which the Naval Support Activity now stands were purchased for an intended Navy yard. The Navy yard was not built, however, and the land was leased for farming. In May of that year additional ground was purchased by the Navy to enlarge the original site.

In November 1901 the Naval Dry Dock (YFD#2) arrived and the U.S. Navy Station was formally established. In 1902 the Commandant, Eighth Naval

District received almost \$4 million for new buildings and improvements to the station. Additional property was obtained giving the Navy almost 3/4 of a mile of valuable river frontage.

The original buildings, some of which still stand, were completed on the site in 1903. Also located on the grounds is a plantation home, built in 1840. Today that home is known simply as Quarters "A" and is occupied by the area's senior Naval flag officer. Quarters "A", an Antebellum Creole style country home, was placed on the National Register in 1993. Quarters "A" sits on what was once Bienville's personal concession.

The Naval Station remained open until September 1911. Following four years of inactivity, it was reopened in 1915 as an industrial Navy yard for repair of vessels. The station continued in full operation until June 1939 when it was placed in a maintenance status. In December 1939 the station was reactivated and eventually became a base to handle transient naval personnel.

In September 1944 the station was designated the U.S. Naval Repair Base. However, just three years later it was redesignated as the U.S. Naval Station, a name it held until January 1962 when it became the Headquarters, Support Activity, New Orleans. This latter name came about to reflect the fact that the Headquarters, Eighth Naval District was aboard the station as a regular tenant.

Located on the east bank of the Mississippi River are the three largest buildings of the Naval Support Activity. The three giant buildings that tower six floors above the river each contain over one-half million square feet of floor space and house a major part of NAVSUPACT tenants.

The 30 acres of land and the three buildings have a history that began in June of 1919 when the buildings were constructed for the U.S. Army Quartermaster Corps for use as a general depot during World War I.

These buildings were partially used by the QM Corps after completion until February 1931 when Buildings 601 and 602 were leased to the Board of Commissioners, Port of New Orleans.

With the advent of World War II the lease was cancelled and the installation reverted to complete use by the military. After the QM Corps gave up the buildings the official title became the New Orleans Port of Embarkation. In 1955 the tract of land was known as the New Orleans Army Terminal. In 1965

the name was changed to the New Orleans Army Base.

There was an expanding naval presence in the lower Mississippi Delta in the middle 60's. In June 1966 the New Orleans Army Base was transferred to the Navy. July 1966 saw the disestablishment of the Headquarters, Support Activity and the establishment of the Naval Support Activity to reflect the changing mission of the station. With this change in mission and designation both sides of the river began serving as the Naval Support Activity for the first time.

Access to Installation: Naval Support Activity is located in New Orleans on the Westbank of the Mississippi River. Take I-10 to US-90 Business West and cross the Crescent City Connection Bridge

to the WESTBANK. Exit at Gen. DeGaulle, South. At the traffic signal turn left onto Shirley Drive, continue straight ahead to the main gate.

The Naval Air Station, Joint Reserve Base, is located in Belle Chasse on the Westbank of the Mississippi River. Take I-10 to US-90 Business West and cross the Crescent City Connection Bridge to the Westbank Expressway. Exit at Lafayette Street. Make a left turn at the traffic light. Keep straight on Belle Chasse Highway LA-23. Go through the tunnel, at the traffic light after the tunnel, make a left turn to go in the back gate or stay on Highway 23 (Belle Chasse HWY) about 7-9 miles to go in the main gate.

Lodging: All personnel checking aboard are advised to make reservations for Temporary Lodging and/or Billeting up to one (1) year in advance. The summer months are extremely busy for PCS moves, so PLAN AHEAD! See Lodging section for phone numbers and details.

Housing: Personnel reporting to Naval Support Activity and Naval Air Station, Joint Reserve Base New Orleans for permanent duty are required to report the Housing Welcome Center at their assigned base. See Housing section in this book for phone numbers and details.

Relocation: The Relocation Assistance Officer is located in building 11, first floor rear at the Naval Support Activity. Relocation Assistance can provide one on one counseling for servicemembers, their family members and retirees, who are relocating to or from the New Orleans area.

New residents must register certificate of title or other evidence of car ownership. LA law requires your car to have a valid state license plate immediately upon establishing a LA residence.

Motor Vehicle Inspection Tags: Residents of Jefferson, Orleans, and St. Bernard parishes must obtain local motor vehicle inspection tags for their automobiles. They are sold only after an automobile has passed examination on brakes, lights, and other items.

In Jefferson and St. Bernard parishes, official inspection stations are maintained at most service stations. The tags must be renewed once a year, for a specified fee. Some incorporated cities or towns in Jefferson Parish have their own inspection requirements. If you are a resident of an incorporated area within Jefferson Parish, we suggest that you obtain information at your municipal government building. For information and the location of official inspection stations in St. Bernard Parish check at 1009 W. Moreau, Chalmette, LA, or call 278-7406.

Orleans Parish (City of New Orleans) has its own motor inspection requirements. Motor vehicle inspection tags in Orleans Parish must be reviewed every year for a specified fee. Official inspection stations in Orleans Parish are located at 400 N. Jefferson Parkway, 482-4445, 3711 General Meyer Avenue, Algiers, LA 361-5567 and other locations in the city.

Climate

The Climate in New Orleans may be classified as humid subtropical with warm & moist summers and wet & mild winters. The Gulf of Mexico to the south and some of the larger lakes have a moderating effect on temperatures. During the summer, afternoon temperatures range from 77 - 105 degrees F while overnight lows almost never drop below 70 degrees F. During the winter months there is an alternating flow of warm tropical air from the south and cold dry continental air from the north. However, the cold spells seldom last more than a few days and the lowest temperatures are usually confined to the 20's and 30's. Snow is a rare occurrence.

During the warm months of the year tropical moisture, afternoon heating, sea and lake breezes and occasional tropical cyclones combine to insure that the region has abundant moisture. In the winter, moist tropical air masses often clash with colder air

from the north to provide ample winter rains. Tornadoes and severe thunderstorms occasionally occur in the region. However the moderating influence of the Gulf of Mexico and the fact that most winter storms move on tracks north of the Middle Gulf limits the number of these destructive storms in comparison to regions to the north. On an occasional basis heavy rains occur. These occur most often during the spring with slow moving, late season winter storms systems and during the summer and early fall with tropical disturbances and cyclones.

Hurricanes are perhaps the greatest threat to that portion of the Middle Gulf Coast region close to the Gulf of Mexico. Destructive winds, flooding by the coastal waters associated with the hurricane's storm surge and heavy rains occur with these storms. During the average decade, 7 hurricanes cross the Middle Gulf Coast region.

HISTORY OF NEW ORLEANS

Bordered by Lake Pontchartrain and the Mississippi River, New Orleans began as a crescent-shaped city on the east bank of the Mississippi. It began as a French settlement in 1718 by Sier de Bienville. As legend has it, by 1762 Louisiana territory was ceded to Spain when Louis XV lost a wager to his cousin, King Charles of Spain. Under Spanish rule from 1762 to 1801, nearby plantations were responsible for establishing the state's sugar industry. Also while a Spanish possession, the Acadains who had been violently expelled from their French Canadian colony by the British and who had wandered back to France and the West Indies in a "Grand Derangement" were accepted by the Spanish king into the colony of Louisiana. For two short years New Orleans was

again a French possession, but in 1803 it was finally part of the U.S. under the terms of the Louisiana Purchase. In 1812 Louisiana was granted statehood. British attempts to blockade and seize New Orleans during the War of 1812 were unsuccessful due to efforts of an unusual alliance of General Andrew Jackson, pirate Jean Lafitte, the Choctaw Indians, Creoles and slaves. By the mid-1800s New Orleans was the fourth largest city in the United States.

Today New Orleans is a 5 mile-wide metropolitan center. With over half a million people residing in the inner city itself and with the metropolitan population topping a million.

Medical and Dental Overview

On 27 September 1978, the Naval Medical Clinic, New Orleans was commissioned as an outpatient service facility. On August 7, 1997 the facility and it's two satellite care centers were re-designated as the Naval Ambulatory Care Center, New Orleans, an out patient service facility and a member of the Naval Hospital Pensacola health care community. The main facility, building H-100, is located on the first floor of the Herbert Tower at the Naval Support Activity in Algiers.

Satellite care centers are also located on the first floor of building 601(EastBank) Naval Support Activity, and building 41, at the Naval Air Station, Joint Reserve Base, Belle Chase. The quality of outpatient care available through these centers will be maintained at the highest level possible contingent upon the resources available.

The Naval Ambulatory Care Center and its satellite centers are able to handle acute medical problems as they arise. However, there are no emergency treatment facility with an emergency room is Keesler Air Force Base in Biloxi, Mississippi, located approximately 90 miles east of New Orleans, LA. In cases of EXTREME or LIFE THREATENING situations, individuals should go directly to a civilian hospital that has an emergency room. All active duty, their beneficiaries, and retired personnel are strongly advised to confer with the Health Benefits

Advisor at the Main Care Center, (504)678-2400 ext. 3039 concerning TRICARE information. All active duty personnel and TRICARE prime personnel enrolled at the main facility seeking care after about 1600 M-F, and during the weekend must notify the Medical Officer of the Day at 678-3660 prior to seeking treatment at a civilian treatment facility. The only exception are cases of extreme or life threatening situations. NOTE: Emergency ambulance service is provided by the appropriate parish, utilizing 911.

Newcomer's Orientation is a two day session, which includes a city tour. Sponsor Training seminars and Smooth Move workshops are offered quarterly at the Transition Assistance Office in Building 11. Before You Move

Comments:

With any relocation, early planning and preparation is essential. Contact your sponsor.

1. Visit your Family Service Center and request a SITES booklet for NSA New Orleans. The Relocation Counselor will also have a Welcome Aboard Package with other valuable information about the base, its activities, and the surrounding community. If there is not one on hand there, feel free to call here and personally request one from us. We will be happy to answer any questions you may have concerning your relocation.

2. It is recommended to call the New Orleans (if appropriate) Chambers of Commerce. They also, have community and informational packets concerning economic, employment, civic, and social issues in their respective counties. This includes maps and brochures. Basing housing is available, but as with any military base, many servicemembers reside off-base. You can receive information on quality of life issues, economics, social events, the most popular, affordable and desirable living areas, etc from the Chambers. This will equip you with helpful information prior to your arrival.

3. Order the local newspaper. This will give you insight on some of your interests and concerns. According to feedback, we found that the TOP 5 areas of concern for this area are:

1. Crime
2. Housing/Apartments
3. Schooling
4. Employment
5. Social Events

4. Discuss/share this information with your family. They too, need to know and understand what they are about to experience. **REMAIN POSITIVE.** Everyone is a bit stressed because of the expectations and uncertainties, remaining optimistic will aide in thier adjustment.

5. TAKE CARE OF YOUR PERSONAL ISSUES:

a. If you are selling a home contact a local realtor to get it sold or rented.

b. If you can control your PCS dates, **DO IT.** Remember schools for the kids, holidays, peak PSC times for the military, deployment schedules and other important events at both current and

destination commands.

c. Construct a financial plan. This plan should cover the ENTIRE RELOCATION PROCESS. The Family Service Center has a financial Counselor available to assist you. Ensure expenses like: house-hunting, automobile expenses, need to have items like, uniform accessories, basic toiletries, etc. are covered.

6. If possible, plan a housing hunting (pre pcs) trip. Make a family vacation out of it. This way everyone can experience what New Orleans is like before you actually move here. This first-hand knowledge will make adjusting to the move easier and will answer some of the uncertainty. **BUDGET FOR THIS TRIP!!**

7. Arrange for a command sponsor. Each command has a sponsor representative/coordinator. The purpose of this individual is to become your point-of-contact and assist you in your transition and relocation to your new command. This person is a valuable source and should be your first acquaintance in the area. They have your interests and concerns at heart so, what better person to assist you than a person who has experienced some of the same things you will. At the time of out-processing request a sponsor through the PSD at your current duty station. If not contact the gaining command. You may also call the Relocation Coordinator, here and we can assist you in that effort. The Military Sponsorship Program is very important, servicemembers can capitalize on the successes you experience and avoid redundant mistakes. Sponsors advise PCS concerns and can help with coordinating final details.

Through all of this, don't forget that you are a professional and will be expected to conduct yourself like one. You are to be commended on your past accomplishments in military. If you have never been in the South, prepare for the humidity in the Spring-Fall months. Summers are 90 degrees plus. Winters are mild. Our cold months are January-March where temperatures are between 40-60 degrees with possibilities of light rains.

After You Arrive

Comments:

Notify Transportation Office of your arrival. Report to Billeting.

Meet with your sponsor.

Visit the Family Service Center for community information and assistance.

Use the Lending Locker, located at the Fleet & Family Service Center (FFSC) Relocation Office in Bldg 11. While you are at the FFSC register for the next Newcomers Orientation. Adult family members are invited to attend.

*If arriving by air, try to arrange for your sponsor to meet you. There are several options for mass transportation from the Airport.

*If arriving by bus, again contact your sponsor, or take a taxi at a cost of about \$20-\$25.

*If arriving by automobile, getting to the base is not difficult. Cross referenced in MUST KNOW ITEMS.

The military always requires you to report in uniform so be prepared!

You'll go to the PSD in building 731 during working hours or the OOD in building 22 after hours. Marines report to building 601, Naval Support Activity (Eastbank)

The Housing Welcome Center, building 267 should be the first stop you make once you arrive. It is recommended that you attend "NEWCOMERS INDOC" as soon as possible. The Fleet & Family Service Center offers a two day workshop with a base and city tour on the second day. Arrange a delivery date with Personal Property.

Reporting Procedures

Comments:

Check-ins are done on a walk-in basis. Ensure you have in your possession:

- a. Original Copies of orders (endorced)
- b. Service Records
- c. Medical record, if applicable
- d. Plane tickets, if applicable
- e. Hotel/Lodging receipts, if applicable
- f. Transportation receipts, if applicable

All incoming officers/enlisted (TDY and PCS) will report to Building 703 enlisted, and building 722 for officer check-in. Servicemembers will need 3 copies of their orders. Students will report to building 703 and will be directed to their command. All servicemembers must report in the uniform of the day. Personnel reporting after duty hours, on weekends, or on holidays will report to the Command Duty Office Building 22.

Reservations for the Navy Lodge are accepted 30 days in advance, from PCS personnel. The telephone number for the Navy Lodge is (504) 366-3266. The administrative office operates from 0645-2200.

Dislocation Allowance (DCA)- equals two months BAQ. Do not expect to receive this money prior to reporting to your new duty station.

Travel Pay- this is mileage related, and is usually not paid until after you check in to the new command.

Vehicle Ownership

Comments:

As with any business, car dealerships are in the business to MAKE MONEY. If you do not own a vehicle and are making plans to purchase, please stop in and see your Command Financial Specialist before you do. If he/she is not readily available in your command. Visit the Fleet & Family Service Center to see the Informational and Referral Specialist. These individuals teach quarterly classes/seminars/workshops on this subject. The FFSC has tips and advice on the subject of automobile markets. There are many places to buy and lease, but our advice is to find out WHO is recommended to buy from before venturing out on your own. Several of our "FIRTS TERMERS" got deals that they did not like or could not negotiate.

By law, LIABILITY Insurance is MANDATORY in the State of Louisiana. You must be able to show proof of insurance. Failure to do so could result in your vehicle being impounded. But statistics show that, NOT EVERYONE IS OBEYING the law. It is important to protect yourself from uninsured motorists. FFSC again, is an excellent point of contact to receive advice in this area. Shop around for comparable rates, before choosing!

For those who own a vehicle, it is required by base regulation that you have a base sticker. You must present as basic requirements:

- a. VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE
- B. PROOF OF VEHICLE INSURANCE
- C. VEHICLE REGISTRATION

While on active duty, there are special benefits you'll receive regarding vehicle licensing and registration. As long as you are on active duty, you are not required to change your license to the state of Louisiana. However, if you purchase Louisiana license plates, you will be required to obtain a Louisiana driver's license.

Members desiring to apply for on base housing must do so within 30 days of their arrival to receive an eligibility date back to the date of departure from their last permanent duty station. If application is made after the initial 30 days, the eligibility date will be the date of the application is received. A copy of PCS orders must be presented with the application for housing. Only the service member can apply for and place their name on the waiting list for on-base housing. However, spouses can be authorized to accept and sign for housing with a Power of Attorney. The 204 family housing units consist of 3 Flag officer quarters, 15 senior grade, 21 field grade, 5 company grade and 160 senior enlisted quarters. You will "SETTLE UP" on all your claims sometime during processing and hopefully this will not be money that is necessary for survival. It is necessary to have money to make deposits on items to secure lodging and housing, enhance your quality of life, or pay bills. Avoid credit, if at all possible, because with interest rates, you can find yourself behind quickly. Remember, there is a financial specialist at Naval Support Activity and there is often one in your command. Assistance is also available through the Navy/Marine Corps Relief Society located in building 11, on the first floor.
