Naval Support Activity Mid-South is located in Millington, TN, 21 miles north of downtown Memphis.

The base is home to Naval Support Activity and host to many tenant activities including Navy Band Mid-South, Navy Personnel Command, Commander Navy Recruiting Command, Defense Automated Printing Service, DeCA Mid-South Defense Commissary, Branch Dental Clinic Mid-South, Defense Investigative Service, Human Resources Office, Branch Medical Clinic Mid-South, Navy Manpower Analysis Center, Navy College Office Millington, Naval Criminal Investigative Service Resident Agency, Navy Exchange Mid-South, Naval Legal Service Office, Naval Telecommunications Center Memphis, Personnel Support Detachment Memphis, Naval Reserve Readiness Command Mid-South, Naval Reserve Center, Resident Officer in Charge of Construction, US Army Corps of Engineers Finance Center(DFAS), Tennessee Army National Guard, US Army Veterinarian Service Millington, Federal Prison, US Post Office, American Red Cross, First South Credit Union, Flying Club, Navy and Marine Corps Relief Society, Millington Municipal Airport, and Millington Aviation Service.

The mission of the Naval Support Activity is to maintain and operate facilities, to provide administrative and logistic support to tenant activities and to perform such other functions and tasks assigned by higher authority.

History of Naval Support Activity Mid-South:

Naval Support Activity (NAVSUPACT) Mid-South, as it is known today, was first commissioned as a Naval Reserve Air Base (NRAB), September 15, 1942. Originally conceived in 1942, the Naval Support Activity emerged from beginnings as Park Field, an Army Signal Corps Aviation School used to train pilots and ground crews for service with the Allied Forces during World War I.

When commissioned as an NRAB, the primary mission of the base was to train aviation pilots to pilot proficiency for action in World War II. NRAB was first officially designated as a Naval Air Station (NAS) January 1, 1943, and encompassed what is now referred to as northside (that area north of Millington-Arlington (Navy) Road), with its administrative buildings and runways.

At the conclusion of World War II, the air station northside was assigned to the Reserve Training Command and was utilized almost exclusively for reserve training until 1948. The concept of the former NAS Memphis was completely changed April 1, 1949. On this date, all support and logistics requirements of the activities aboard the naval reservation, including the area south of Navy Road, except the Naval Hospital, were assigned as responsibilities of the former naval air station. The original 2,200 acre base had grown to a 3,500 acre complex; from a \$203,000 parcel of land to a community of land, buildings, and equipment with a replacement value of over one billion dollars; from a two-room operation in the Shelby County Courthouse to one of the largest inland installations in the world.

NAVSUPACT Memphis, previously NAS Memphis, was officially established October 1, 1995, as a result of the 1993 Base Realignment and Closure Commission. The name was changed to Naval Support Activity Mid-South October 1, 1998, to more closely identify the base's mission requirements and to reflect the Navy's approach to regionalization.

Also directed by BRAC, on March 9, 1999, the Naval Brig building and a 4 acre section on which it stood on the northside of the base, was transferred to the City of Millington. On January 11, 2000, two other plots of land on the northside, the airfield section, consisting of 538 acres and the non-airfield section, some 1,329 acres adjoining the airfield, were also transferred to Millington.

The size of the Navy Mid-South complex has decreased to approximately 1,600 acres, mostly on the southside of Navy Road; a new, smaller

community of land, buildings and equipment with a replacement value now of about \$500 million.

Today the Naval Support Activity operates and functions with an allowance of approximately 600 enlisted and officer personnel, civilians, and full-time contract personnel who provide all essential logistic and operational support services to the commands and activities on board. Considered by resident activities as the landlord of Navy Mid-South, the Naval Support Activity performs the many tasks necessary for the proper functioning of a self-contained city, including housing, food service, utilities and facilities for purchase of essential food stuffs and personal items.

Located in Millington, Tennessee, some 10 miles north of the city of Memphis, the Naval Support Activity is 7 miles east of the Mississippi River. As the base has evolved and changed, so has its impact on the area. It plays an important part in the Memphis community and is one of the largest single businesses in the state of Tennessee.

The primary tenant of NAVSUPACT Mid-South is the Bureau of Naval Personnel, which recently relocated here from Washington, DC. The command is now known as the Navy Personnel Command. The following is a history of the Bureau of Naval Personnel: Naval personnel matters were originally handled by the Secretary of War until the establishment of the Navy Department on 30 April 1798. It was not until 1815 that the Secretary of the Navy took control of personnel matters. In 1861, the Office of Detail was created and functions related to the detailing of officers and the appointment and instruction of volunteer officers, as well as the purchase of ships and related matters were transferred. The Bureau of Equipment and Recruiting was concurrently established to handle enlisted recruiting and service record maintenance. The Bureau of Navigation was established in 1862 and three years later the office of Detail was placed under it. In 1889, The Bureau of Equipment and Recruiting transferred its enlisted personnel activities to the Bureau of Navigation as well. On 13 May 1942, the command's name changed to the Bureau of Naval Personnel, and in 1982 it changed to Naval Military Personnel Command. In 1991, the name changed back to the Bureau of Naval Personnel or "BUPERS" for short. BUPERS is led by the Chief of Naval Personnel. The organizational chart for Navy Personnel Command is as follows: NPC-00, Commander, Navy Personnel Command; NPC-01, Administrative Officer; NPC-02, Comptroller/Resources Management Office; NPC-

03, Management & Organizational Services Office; NPC-05, Public Affairs Office; NPC-06, Office of Legal Counsel; NPC-3, Business Operations; NPC-4, Distribution; NPC-6, Personal Readiness & Community Support; NPC-8, Pers Progression, Performance & Security; and NPC-9, Reserve Personnel Management.

To reach the Naval Support Activity from the Memphis International Airport take Winchester Road West, heading north. Take Interstate 240 East, taking the interstate approximately 10 miles. Do not take the Nashville exit; continue on I-240. Look for NAVSUPACT Mid-South and Covington Pike exit. Take Covington Pike exit (North) for approximately 5 miles. Covington Pike changes to Singleton Parkway at the Covington Pike/Austin Peay intersection. Take Singleton Parkway 5 miles (through 4 way stop) to the South Gate of NSA.

Secondary route from the airport to base: Take Winchester Road West exit, heading north. Take Interstate 240 West (Downtown/Little Rock exit), taking the interstate approximately 10 miles. Look for the Millington exit. Take Highway 51 North through Frayser/Northgate area, approximately 11 miles. Once in Millington, the first major intersection at the second traffic light is Navy Road. Turn right on Navy Road through 3 traffic lights (3 miles) to NSA.

There is no direct bus transportation to the base. The nearest Greyhound bus stop is at 7750 Hwy 51 North, Millington. This is approximately 3 miles from the base.

Arrival and check in procedures - cross reference to the Category RELOCATION SERVICES, Subject Area; PCS REPORTING PROCEDURES.

For temporary quarters information - cross reference to the Category RELOCATION SERVICES, Subject Area; BILLETING.

During certain annual events held in Memphis, all hotels and motels are booked. Namely the events are: Memphis in May; Elvis Week in August; some Motorsports Events; COGIC Convention; and the Liberty Bowl in December. There is a Comfort Inn and a Best Western located in Covington in Tipton

County. There is a Days Inn in Ripley which is near Covington, on Highway 51.

For child care information - cross reference to the Category CHILD AND TEEN SERVICES.

For pet information - cross reference to the Category RELOCATION SERVICES, Subject Areas; PET BOARDING, LICENSING, QUARANTINES, VETERINARY SERVICES AND PET TRANSPORTATION.

IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS TO HAND CARRY: When reporting to NAVSUPACT Mid-South have your original orders, service record, and pay record. Have a copy of your housing information or non-availability form from the barracks if there is no room for you to stay there. Contact PSD at 901-874-5875 for more information.

The military clause will not allow a member to be released from a rental agreement (lease) to obtain on base housing at NAVSUPACT Mid-South. If there is not any base housing available when the member applies and community housing is required, the member will be placed on deferment until their lease expires. A lease is a binding contract and the "military clause" will allow the member to break it ONLY if they receive PCS orders. Cross reference to the Category HOUSING.

Cost of living in the Memphis area is slightly below the national average. Memphis has a sales tax of 8.25 percent. TN has no Personal Income Tax. Cross reference to the Category RELOCATION

SERVICES, Subject Area; FINANCIAL PREPAREDNESS. Other Restrictions: All firearms must be registered on base. If owners live in barracks, firearms must be stored in armory. Registered firearms may be kept in quarters. Peculiar/Unique Regulations/Restrictions: Motorcycles may not be registered on base until the owner has completed the locally taught and frequently offered motorcycle defensive driver course. To register you must contact the Consolidated Safety Office at 874-5506. Military who own or operate a motorcycle, scooter, or motorized bicycle and wish to operate the vehicle on or off station must attend this course. Civilian employees who wish to operate these vehicles on station must also attend the course.

Base Public Information: The NSA Public Affairs Office, located in Building S-455, maintains an Internet site located in the Overview Web address above. This site contains a wealth of up to date information about the base and local activities. Additionally, the PAO maintains an Intranet page which is updated daily with news you can use.

Every Thursday the base newspaper, The Bluejacket, is published and distributed. The Bluejacket is packed with information from NSA and the tenant commands as well as recreation schedules. It is a "commercial enterprise" newspaper meaning it depends on advertising revenue to be self-sufficient; however, not-for-profit classified ads are available to base personnel free of charge. The editorial office for the Bluejacket is located within the Public Affairs Office.

Comments: Hours of operation - 0830 - 1700 Monday - Friday. Testing stops at 1600. If personnel have an out-of-state license, they must present it & one other form of ID, and only a vision test will be required. If no valid license, they must take a vision, written & driving test. Take U S 51 North, turn left on West Union which is approximately 1 mile out of city limits. The state of TN gives you 30 days to get a license once you have established permanent residency. There are three other testing station locations in Memphis: 6348 Summer; 3200 E. Shelby Drive; and 3516 Park Ave. Each location can be reached at 543-7920.

Handled by the Shelby County Clerk's Office, there are 10 locations. If moving from out of state bring current registration, title or name & address of lien holder. Memphis city residents are required to have their cars inspected. There are 3 inspection stations located at: 590 Washington Ave; 1720 RKS Commercial Cove & 855 N. White Station. There are long lines around the first and last of the month. The cost of the tags varies. It's \$77 in Memphis, \$72 in Germantown, \$67 in Collierville, \$62 in

Bartlett, \$57 in Millington and \$47 for other county residents. For new residents, a one-time title fee is an additional \$10. Also add \$1, if you mail in your renewals. For personalized plates, add another \$25 a year. Call 576-4252 or 4244.

Education Overview

EDUCATION IN MEMPHIS

There are three public school systems that serve the Memphis area. All city and county schools are fully accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. The school board numbers are listed below.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:

Children must be 5 years old on or before September 30 of the calendar year to enter kindergarten. They must be 6 years old on or before September 30 of the calendar year to enter first grade. A Student entering kindergarten must have a physical examination (within last six months), Permanent Tennessee Certificate of Immunization (green form) or a temporary Certificate of Immunization, birth certificate (certified copy) and social security number. Parents may be asked to provide a Proof of Residence.

All other grades require a copy of the last report card and proof of address. The local school will request records from the previous school attended, so please have that address. Students transferring into the system from out of state or from a non-public school must provide a Permanent Tennessee Certificate of Immunization or Temporary Certificate of Immunization which is up to date. The student must live with a parent or legal guardian within the Memphis City limits in order to attend a city school. The student must live with a parent or legal guardian outside the Memphis City limits, but inside Shelby County, in order to attend Shelby County Schools. If you wish to attend a city school but live in the county, you must pay tuition.

PRIVATE AND PAROCHIAL SCHOOLS:

Private and parochial schools abound in the Memphis metropolitan area. There are also schools for exceptional children. Memphis also has four-year degree granting colleges, junior colleges, and many business and technical schools. Check your yellow page directory.

SPECIAL EDUCATION:

Both city and county schools offer special education at various locations, and transportation is provided to the school offering classes for the particular need.

CLUE PROGRAM:

The Clue program, which services the gifted child, is offered at both city and county schools.

The Tipton County School System is responsible for the education of over 9,000 students. There are five elementary schools, K-5 with locations in Brighton, Covington, Drummonds and Munford. There are three middle schools, located in Munford and Covington, and three high schools, located in Brighton, Munford and Covington. For more detailed information on any of these schools, please contact the Tipton County Board of Education or visit their web site at tiptonk12.tn.us.

The Shelby County School System serves over 45,000 in 45 schools. This includes all the public schools in the county outside the corporate limits of

Memphis, including the schools located in Arlington, Bartlett, Collierville, Germantown, Lakeland and Millington. For registration and further information, visit their web site at scs.k12.tn.us. The Memphis City School System serves over 110,000 students in 161 schools, 28 of which are optional schools. An optional school offers special study programs in (1) creative and performing arts, (2) health sciences and engineering, (3) international studies and (4) college preparatory. Some schools are all-optional and others are "schools within schools". Requirements for entry into an optional school vary: achievement test scores, good conduct and attendance, and certain grade point averages. There is an optional school fair in November and registration usually begins the first Friday in February. Call 901-325-5338 for more information on the optional program.

The Memphis city school system is the largest school system in the state of TN. All city schools were connected to the Internet in October 1996. Parents and students are required to sign a permission slip to use Internet at school.

Memphis City Schools has its own live, call-in radio show. "Children First Newslines" is a weekly show that airs each Thursday at 6 p.m. on WQOX 88.5 FM and provides the public with information about what's going on in the school system.

An open enrollment policy was approved in November 1996 by the Memphis Board of Education to give parents more choice in their children's school assignment. All transfers to another school are based on available space. Transportation to these choice transfers will not be provided. Call 901-325-5380 for more information.

COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE There are compulsory school attendance laws. Some pertinent laws are: (1) Every parent of a child 7 - 17 years of age must require the child to attend school. A person who fails to do so may be fined \$50.00 for every day a child is unlawfully absent. (2) A child who is unlawfully kept out of school may be found by Juvenile Court to be a dependent and neglected child and removed from the home. The parent may be punished by fine and/or imprisonment. (3) The school principal is required by law to report to the school superintendent children who are absent without proper excuse as much as five days during the school year. The school superintendent must report to the Juvenile Court Judge. (4) Memphis Police Officers, and other law enforcement officers, have been instructed to take into custody and deliver either to school or to the Juvenile Court Detention

Center children found in the community during school hours who are truant from school.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS To graduate, a student shall: (1) achieve specified units of credit; 20 in the University Path, 20 in the Technical Path or 21 in the Combined Path (University and Technical); (2) make passing scores on the mathematics and English subtest of the Tennessee State Proficiency Test (TPT)/Tennessee Comprehensive Assessment program Competency Test (TCAP/CT) and (3) complete an exit exam to assess readiness for the work place or higher education.

GRADING SCALE The grading scale is as follows: A - 100-93; B - 92-85; C - 84-75; D - 74-70; F - 69 & below.

All personnel should have Family members enrolled in TRICARE Family Member Dental Plan which is United Concordia Plan. Dental facilities on base are limited and are for Active Duty personnel. Family Service Center, Branch Medical Clinic Managed Care Office, and Dental Clinic can give an up to date listing of local area providers.

The Tricare Active Duty Family Member Dental Plan (FMDP) is administered by United Concordia Companies, Inc. in Camp Hill, Pennsylvania. It is a voluntary comprehensive dental plan available to family members of all active duty Uniformed Services personnel. When the active duty member (sponsor) enrolls family members in the FMDP, a monthly premium is paid through payroll deduction. The plan has cost shares, maximum, and limitations similar to typical civilian dental group plans. The amount covered by the plan ranges from 100 percent to 50 percent, depending on the type of service. Family members must receive dental services in the United States, Canada, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands or Puerto Rico.

Detailed FMDP coverage and enrollment information are contained in the FMDP Benefit Booklet. Sponsors and family members may call United

TRICARE RETIREE DENTAL PROGRAM: The Defense Department's Tricare Retiree Dental Program (TRDP) is a voluntary enrollment program established by Congress that offers diagnostic, preventive, and basic restorative services; oral surgery; and emergency services. Coverage under the TRDP is available to personnel retired from the Uniformed Services of the United States, their unremarried surviving spouses, and to certain other eligible family members for care.

The TRDP is administered by Delta Dental of California under a contract awarded by the Department of Defense on October 21, 1997. TRDP coverage is available beginning 1 February 1998. The TRDP offers continuous open enrollment. Initial enrollment is for at least 24 months. After the first 24-month period, enrollees may choose to stay enrolled on a month-to-month basis. Enrollees who disenroll at any time, regardless of the reason, will be subject to a one-year lockout period. Enrollment is handled by Delta Dental Plan of California, the civilian contractor that administers the TRDP.

All premium costs are paid by the retiree; there is no government contribution. Premiums will be collected monthly through payroll deduction or if such pay is not available, by direct monthly billings. Enrollees must submit a prepayment equal to four months' worth of premiums with their initial enrollment application. The monthly premiums vary depending on the location of the retiree's primary residence and the type of enrollment - single, two party, or family. Care is provided by civilian dentists.

Apartments, duplexes, and multi-unit dwellings range from \$400 for a one-bedroom to \$600 for a three-bedroom unit per month. Mobile home rentals usually range in price from \$250 to \$400 per month.

The average rental price for an apartment is \$550 per month. Four-bedroom houses are limited and rent for \$900 a month and up; three-bedroom homes are more readily available and usually rent for \$700 a month and up; two-bedroom homes, when available, usually rent for \$450 and up. When leasing an apartment, house, or mobile home, members can expect to pay the first month's rent, plus a cleaning/damage/security deposit of approximately \$100 to \$300. In addition, credit checks or application fees ranging from \$10 to \$30 (non-refundable) are required. Utilities are commonly the responsibility of the tenant, which would also include a deposit for hook-up. Utility bills can be expensive during winter months and the Memphis area's very hot summer months. Your Basic Allowance for Housing will not cover all of the monthly rental costs for this area. It is extremely difficult to find suitable housing for families who have large pets or more than one pet. Some apartment complexes will accept pets; however, there is a 15 to 20-pound maximum weight limit. When pets are allowed, there is usually an additional non-

refundable deposit ranging from \$50 to \$250, with an added fee to the monthly rental costs.

The military clause will not allow a member to be released from a rental agreement (lease) to obtain on base housing at NAVSUPACT Mid-South. If there is not any base housing available when the member applies and community housing is required, the member will be placed on deferment until their lease expires. A lease is a binding contract and the "military clause" will allow the member to break it ONLY if they receive PCS orders.

Complete the application and mail or fax it to the housing office of your future duty station along with a copy of your orders and a copy of your Page 2 (Record of Emergency Data).

Procedure for obtaining on-base housing upon arrival-- Visit the housing office at Bldg S-781 and fill out the application (DD-1746). You will also need to have a copy of your orders and page 2 (Record of Emergency Data). You cannot be placed on the list unless you have all of this information. The approximate waiting list in months is indefinite due to the base realignment.

Per OPNAVINST 11101.21, all military members are directed to report to the Housing Referral Office, Building S-781, prior to negotiating any civil agreement for off-base housing. The office is open from 0730 to 1600, Monday through Friday,

excluding holidays. The Housing Office will assist members locating suitable housing upon their arrival.

Household Goods Out-Bound Shipments

This information is designed for military personnel and DOD members who are preparing for shipment of household goods. It is based on entitlements found in Joint Federal Travel Regulation (JFTR), JTR, & applicable service entitlement publications.

Generally, the Permanent Change of Station (PCS) and arrangement of household goods begin once the service member receives orders from the Personnel Support Detachment (PSD) and a destination site has been determined. Specific arrangements for personal shipments normally begin at the local transportation office. Each pay grade has its own weight allowance which is the maximum weight that can be moved at government expense under JFTR. The allowance includes the weight of household goods shipped, placed in storage or sent as unaccompanied baggage. Anything exceeding the maximum weight allowances must be paid by the service member. All shipments are weighed before destination delivery and can be coordinated with the local transportation office.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED: 6 copies of orders (and amendments, if any) are required to assure having copies to cover each type of shipment. Service members can appoint someone to conduct their shipment plans for them. The appointment must be a power of attorney and a copy must be furnished to the transportation office when arranging the shipment.

STORAGE: The government provides two types of storage: Temporary and Non-Temporary. Temporary storage can run for 90 days. It can be used at either origin, en route, or at destination. Additional extensions can be obtained by submitting

a formal request in writing. Service members are expected to pay for any temporary storage time exceeding the 360-day period. Non-Temporary storage is Long-term storage authorized in specific cases, such as an overseas assignment or base overflow. NAVSUPACT Mid-South has no storage facilities on base. It is sub contracted to DOD approved storage facilities.

SHIPMENT ITEMS are household furnishings, appliances, equipment, clothing, personal effects, professional books, papers and equipment, motorcycles and spare parts for a privately owned vehicle.

Be sure to set up a counseling appointment with your local travel office, once new PCS orders are in hand, for a smooth coordination of all shipment arrangements.

Contact the Relocation Assistance Program (RAP) Counselor at 901-874-5075/5375 if you are interested in having a sponsor. The Youth Center has agreed to work with RAP if a sponsor is requested for your child/children.

Youth Employment

The FFSC ERO, is probably the best place to go for guidance and information on volunteer/career opportunities for youth. The major coordinating and training agency for youth volunteers is through the American Red Cross, 901-726-1690, Cathy Maxwell. You must go through the downtown office, not the base Red Cross office. Start deciding about summer volunteer plans early, maybe in March. If you want summer employment on or off base, start early too. Youth Programs hire teens but positions are highly sought. MIFA (Metropolitan Interfaith Association) takes applications in November for employment the following summer. There are income and other restrictions. Check with ERO for other avenues. Try Girls Inc. of Memphis, 901-523-0217; Memphis Partners, 901-362-4053; United Methodist Centers, 901-323-4993; Urban League YES, 901-327-3591, or Private Industry Council (PIC), 901-576-6536. Job Shadowing is another way to check out careers and gain work experience. ERO will try to help you locate an appropriate site.

DRIVER'S LICENSE: You may get your permit at age fifteen. If you have not had Driver's Education, you must have your permit for three months before obtaining your license. Applicants under 18 must bring a school attendance form, and birth certificate. A parent must sign a financial responsibility form.

Survival Tips For First Termers

Survival Tips for First Termers Overview

Currently, the base is undergoing major changes. The mission has become a personnel/administrative management mission. The Navy Personnel Command and other office executive agencies are relocating here. This means that newcomer relocation concerns/needs will go from "first term" to "first timer". What we mean is that most of the military personnel we dealt with in the past were personnel going to their "first ever" duty station. Our customers in the future will mostly be more senior servicemembers, who have experienced a PCS before. This section is intended to discuss the issues for both categories of movers.

Before You Move

With any relocation, planning and preparation is essential. **AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE:**

1. Go to your Family Service Center and request a SITES booklet for NAVSUPACT Mid-South. The Relocation Counselor will also have a Welcome Aboard Package with other valuable information about the base, its activities, and the surrounding community. If there is not a Welcome Aboard Package available, feel free to call 901-874-5075/5375, and request one from us. We will be glad to answer any questions you may have concerning your relocation.

2. It is recommended that you call the Memphis and Tipton County Chambers of Commerce. All area Chambers of Commerce listings may be found in the EMPLOYMENT Category, Subject Area; Chambers of Commerce. The Chambers of Commerce also have community and informational packets concerning economic, employment, civic, and social issues in their respective counties. This includes maps and brochures. There is base housing available here, but as with any military base, many servicemembers reside off-base. You can receive information on quality of life issues, economics, social events, the most popular, affordable and desirable living areas, etc. from the Chambers. This will give you information to ponder and/or investigate once you arrive.

3. Order the local newspaper. This will give you insight on some of your interests and concerns. According to feedback, we found that the TOP 5 areas of concern for this area are: a. HOUSING/APARTMENTS b. SOCIAL EVENTS c. CRIME d. SCHOOLING e. EMPLOYMENT

4. Ensure that you discuss/share the information you are gathering with your family. They, too, need to know and understand what they are about to experience. **REMAIN POSITIVE** through this initial period. Everyone is a bit stressed because of the expectations and uncertainties, so remaining optimistic will help in their adjustment. The most important and constant thing throughout all of this period is your **LOVED ONES**.

5. TAKE CARE OF YOUR PERSONAL ISSUES:

a. If you are selling a home, start the necessary procedures to get it sold or rented. If this is not possible, select your representatives(s) and get the process started. There is literature with real estate agencies, banks, and the library that has informative tips on how to prepare and execute this action.

b. If you can control your PCS dates, **DO IT**. Remember schools for the kids, holidays, peak PCS times for the military, deployment schedules and other important events at both current and destination commands. c. Put together a financial plan. This plan should cover the **ENTIRE RELOCATION PROCESS**. The Family Service Center has a Financial Counselor that is available to assist you. Ensure expenses like: house-hunting, automobile expenses, need-to-have items like uniform accessories, basic toiletries, etc. are covered.

6. If possible, plan a **PRE-PCS** trip. Make it a family vacation. This way everyone can see and experience what Memphis and the Mid-South is like before you actually reside here. This first-hand knowledge obtained will make adjustment that much easier and will answer some of the uncertainty. **ENSURE YOU PUT THIS IN THE BUDGET!!!!**

7. Arrange for a command sponsor. Each command has a sponsor representative/coordinator. The purpose of this individual(s) is to become your point-of-contact and assist you in your transition and relocation to your new command. This person is a valuable source and should be your first acquaintance in the area. They have your interests and concerns at heart - what better person to assist you than a person

who experienced many of the same things you will also. While out-processing, you should be given the opportunity to request a sponsor at PSD. If not, you may call your unit directly. You also may call the Relocation Coordinator here, telephone 901-874-5075/5375 and we will link you with designated command representatives. The Military Sponsorship Program is very important because servicemembers can capitalize on the successes you experience and avoid redundant mistakes. Sponsors advise on any/all of your concerns and can help with any coordination that must be done.

Through all of this, don't forget that you are a professional and will be expected to conduct yourself like one. You are to be commended on your past accomplishments in your military endeavors and you should relax and reflect on those and the future. But don't relax too much!!! Avoid trouble at all costs. Don't arrive at the unit late, WITH EXCUSES. Ensure you are "SHIP SHAPE": orders, records, uniform, etc. FIRST IMPRESSIONS MEAN EVERYTHING, and we certainly don't want to start off with nothing short of that at our new units!!!!

If you have never been in the South, prepare for heat and humidity in the Spring - Fall months. Summers are 90-plus degree days. Winters are mild, with little accumulation of snow. Our cold months are Jan - Mar where temperatures are between 0 - 35 degrees with possibilities of light snow/hail/ice storms.

After You Arrive

If arriving by air, try to have your sponsor meet you at the airport.

If arriving by bus, you'll need a taxi from the bus station either in Memphis or Millington, to the base. Try to ensure that your bus ticket has you dropped at Millington instead of Memphis. It is almost a \$25.00 difference in cab fare. (CROSS REFERENCE SECTION: INSTALLATION, CATEGORY: TRANSPORTATION).

If arriving by automobile, getting to the base is not difficult. It is well advertised on the expressway (I-240 loop). CROSS REFERENCE SECTION: INSTALLATION, SECTION: MUST KNOW ITEMS.

The military always requires you to report in uniform, so be prepared! If reporting after hours, you'll go to Security in Building S-237 get your orders stamped. If reporting during working hours, check in with your command first. You will be

introduced to your Pass Liaison Representative (PLR). The PLR will contact PSD to set up an appointment.

As soon as possible, report in! Ensure that the Housing Office is one of your first stops. They have valuable information on both temporary and permanent housing assets. We hope to see you in the Relocation Office shortly thereafter so we can also advise you on your relocation needs. It is also recommended that you attend "INDOCTRINATION" as soon as possible after arrival. The NAVSUPACT Mid-South Training Department coordinates this 5 day briefing; it is as informative as it gets, covering all aspects of the base!!!!

The Personal Property Office should also be visited! If the military moved your household goods, it is important that you discuss the specifics about receiving them as soon as possible.

Reporting Procedures

CROSS REFERENCE SECTION: RELOCATION SERVICES, CATEGORY: PCS REPORTING PROCEDURES.

Check in with your command OOD. They will introduce you to the Pass Liaison Representative (PLR). The PLR will set up an appointment for you to check in with PSD.

At the time of your appointment at PSD, Bldg. S-456, ensure you have in your possession:

- a. ORIGINAL COPIES OF ORDERS (ENDORSED)
- b. SERVICE RECORD
- c. MEDICAL RECORD AND DENTAL RECORD
- d. PLANE TICKETS, IF APPLICABLE
- e. HOTEL/LODGING RECEIPTS, IF APPLICABLE
- f. TRANSPORTATION RECEIPTS, IF APPLICABLE
- g. PRT FOLDERS FOR ENLISTED

Travel Planning

If you are planning a vacation or any travel ventures (in route or after arrival), please come into the Relocation Office for information. We provide some maps, comprehensive route schedules, and recommended sights to see during travel and at destination by using our new automated Rand-McNally TRIPMAKER program. This program is an automated road atlas and travel guide that covers information for the entire United States and some U.S. territories. Come and take advantage of this great resource! We are, of course, well versed and

familiar with the Mid-South areas and can tell you the sights here from experience.

The main branch of the AAA Office is on the corner of Park Avenue and White Station Boulevard (5138 Park Avenue) in Memphis. One of the more popular travel agencies, they too have comprehensive information on any destination worldwide you may want to visit. Membership in the Club extends further benefits. Call (901) 761-5371 or 1-800-365-4840 for further information.

There are also other miscellaneous travel agencies throughout the city that can assist in your travel planning. See the local yellow pages for this extensive listing.

Vehicle Ownership

As with any business, car dealerships are in the business to MAKE MONEY. If you do not own a vehicle and are making plans to purchase, please stop in and see your Command Financial Specialist before you do. If he/she is not readily available in your command, come to the Family Service Center to see ours. These individuals teach periodic classes/seminars/workshops on this very subject. ABHC Pope, the FSC LCPO, has some interesting tips and advice on the subject for both Millington and Memphis automobile markets. There are many places to go and buy or lease, but our advice is to check with the FSC for car buying tips before venturing out on your own. Several of our "FIRST TERMERS" got deals that they did not like or could not obligate. Just extra headaches you don't need!!!

By law, insurance is MANDATORY in the State of Tennessee. But statistics show that, NOT EVERYONE IS OBEYING the law. It is important to protect yourself from uninsured motorists. ABHC Pope, again, is an excellent point of contact to receive advice in this area. Shop around for comparable rates, before choosing! For those who own a vehicle, it is required by base regulations that you have a base sticker. You must present as basic requirements:(CROSS REFERENCE SECTION: INSTALLATION, CATEGORY: MUST KNOW INFO)

- a. ID CARD
- b. PRESENT DRIVER'S LICENSE
- c. PROOF OF VEHICLE INSURANCE
- d. VEHICLE REGISTRATION

While on active duty, you receive benefits regarding vehicle licensing and registration. As long as you are on active duty, you are NOT required to be licensed

in the State of Tennessee. However, if you purchase Tennessee license plates for whatever reason, you will be required to obtain Tennessee driver's license. The military fee for automobile registration and plates is \$33.00. For further information, CROSS REFERENCE SECTION: INSTALLATION, CATEGORY: REGULATIONS.

Housing and Billeting

You will be coordinating temporary and permanent housing once you report. PSD will start the temporary housing process. Temporary Lodging Expense (TLE) is authorized to partially offset the added living expenses incurred by servicemembers and their family members, when it is necessary to occupy temporary lodging with the PCS. This refers to lodging obtained by the member at the old or new duty station. TLE is payable for lodging obtained by the member when per diem is not otherwise payable. You are entitled to 10 DAYS maximum at \$110.00 daily. Keep in mind, that TLE is the ONLY allowance that CANNOT be paid in advance, because you can only be reimbursed for actual lodging. Ensure you discuss this matter with the PSD Travel/Financial points of contact while in-processing. Yes, temporary lodging is available on and off-base. CROSS REFERENCE SECTION: INSTALLATION, CATEGORY: COMMONLY REFERENCED NUMBERS to obtain Housing and Billeting information.

Your next stop should be in the Housing Office. They will be able to discuss with you specifics about on and off base housing options. They also have a referral service. CROSS REFERENCE SECTION "HOUSING".

Ultimately, we hope to see you in the Relocation Office. If you have not received your Welcome Aboard package, here is your chance to obtain one. We have made this package as comprehensive as possible with information on various housing topics: real estate, housing, and apartment information. Our information is intended to "supplement" housing information, not replace it. It is strongly recommended that you see the "experts" FIRST!

Money Matters

Yes, the cost of living here is one advantage. But initially, you may not see that advantage. RELOCATION IS STILL EXPENSIVE!!!! Ensure that you have considered a financial approach for the move. You will "SETTLE UP" on all your claims sometime during in-processing and hopefully this will not be money that is "necessary" for survival. This

money will be nice to have for deposits on items to get your lodging/housing situation taken care of, enhance your quality of life, or pay bills. Avoid credit, if at all possible, because with current interest rates, you can find yourself behind quickly.

Remember, in Building S-456 (Fleet and Family Center), there is a financial counselor to assist you, if needed. In the same building, the Navy/Marine Corps Relief Society is there for emergencies.
